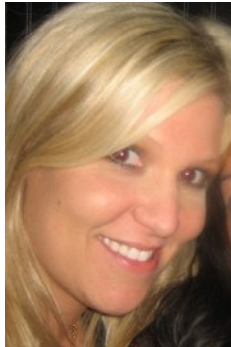


Meet WAA's NextGen Committee Members:
